DELAYED START TO THE SCHOOL DAY: FRIDAY, 23rd SEPTEMBER 2011

During the course of every academic year, we raise a significant amount of money for charity. In doing so, we highlight to the students many worthy causes and give everyone associated with the school an opportunity to contribute in some way.

In order to support the Macmillan Cancer Care charity, students are given the opportunity to take part in a 'coffee morning' which is organised by the students in Ash House. This event is happening later in this first half of term. We also like to give staff an opportunity to participate in a 'Macmillan Coffee Morning'. We first introduced this event two years ago and have raised a considerable amount of money for this charity as a result.

Our staff fund raising coffee morning has once again been scheduled for the day after our Open Evening, **Friday, 23rd September**. In order to accommodate this, **morning registration will start at 9.45 a.m.** instead of 8.45 a.m. Periods 2 to 5 will then run as normal. **We have arranged for our school buses to pick up at all the usual stops an hour later than normal in order to accommodate this.** If, for any reason, you would still prefer your son/daughter to arrive at school prior to 9.40 a.m., the Refectory will be open to students from 8.00 a.m. and they will be able to sit inside and buy drinks/breakfast as usual. The slightly later start has the added advantage that students who are involved in our Open Evening get a longer rest and it gives staff some time the next morning to complete the 'tidying up' so that the school is ready for normal lessons.

School will **finish at the normal time of 3.20 p.m.** on Friday, 23 September and buses will collect and drop off in the usual way.
