Today your son/daughter has been given details of the wide range of activities available for the three days of Curriculum Xtra, and how they can sign up for these Activities. Please spend some time discussing these with your child and encouraging them to make the most of these opportunities.

The Activities List gives details of each activity's venue, the Activity Leader and the total cost, if there is a charge. All activities have a limit on the number of students who can participate due to Health and Safety Regulations. Further details of each activity, including how to make any payment required or how to give parental consent will be provided by the Activity Leaders. You should contact the Activity Leader in the first instance if you have a query.
