

Tytherington High School Association 500 Club Rules

1. The object of the club is to raise funds for Tytherington High School.
2. The club will be run under the supervision of the THSA who will also administer the club.
3. The promoter is Mrs Clare Brown, 53 Millers Meadow, Rainow, Macclesfield, SK10 5UE.
4. The club is open to all parents, friends and staff of Tytherington High School. Members must be over 18 years of age and must fill in an application form.
5. Entry will be by subscription of £1 per month per number, paid a year in advance by cheque or monthly by direct debit. Members may have more than one number.
6. A number will be allocated by the THSA committee for each entry and the subscriber will be made aware of their number(s).
7. Numbers will be drawn by the THSA at their meetings for previous undrawn months. Winners' names will be posted on the THSA page of the school website and they will receive a cheque in the post.
8. Subscriptions will be accepted by cheque on a yearly basis for one to four numbers per month, and by standing order for five numbers or above per month.
9. New members will be admitted when numbers become available. A waiting list will be kept and numbers will be offered to the first person on the list.
10. The regular monthly prize money will be as follows:
 - 1st: £70
 - 2nd: £20
 - 3rd: £10
11. The relevant numbers of all paid up members will be entered in the draw for each month.
12. Registers will be kept recording the name and address of each member, the number(s) allocated to them and the subscriptions received from them.
13. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the club if his or her renewal of subscription remains unpaid for a period of one month.
14. The rules of the 500 club may be amended by the THSA.
15. The decision of the THSA shall be final and binding on all matters relating to the operation of the 500 club.
16. 500 club accounts shall be kept by the THSA treasurer and be examined annually with the formal accounts.
